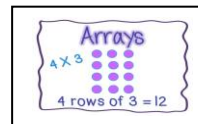

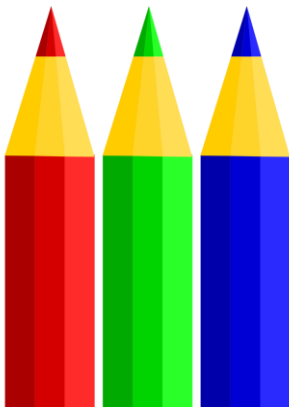

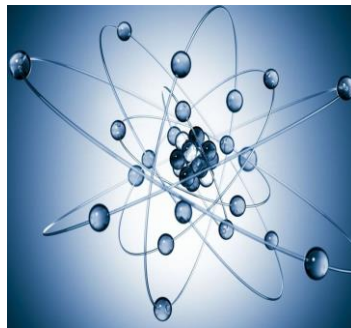
Handwriting
